SECTION 1: IDENTIFICATION

SECTION 2: HAZARD(S) IDENTIFICATION

Classification of the Substance or Mixture (GHS): Flammable Liquid, Category 3; Eye Irritation, Category 2A; Skin Sensitization, Category 1B

Hazard Statements: Flammable liquid and vapor. Causes serious eye irritation. May cause an allergic skin reaction.

Precautionary Statements - Prevention: Keep away from heat, hot surfaces, sparks, open flames, and other ignition sources. No smoking. Keep container tightly closed. Ground and bond container and receiving equipment where applicable during bulk handling. Avoid breathing vapors or mist. Avoid contact with eyes and skin. Wash thoroughly after handling. Contaminated work clothing should not be allowed out of the workplace.

Precautionary Statements - Response: If on skin: Wash with plenty of soap and water. If skin irritation or rash occurs: Get medical advice/attention. SECTION 4: FIRST-AID MEASURES

Inhalation: Move exposed person to fresh air. Keep at rest in a position comfortable for breathing. Seek medical attention if symptoms persist.

SECTION 5: FIRE-FIGHTING MEASURES

Suitable Extinguishing Media: Alcohol-resistant foam, dry chemical, carbon dioxide (CO₂)

Unsuitable Extinguishing Media: Do not use direct water jet, as this may spread the fire.

Specific Hazards Arising from the Chemical: Flammable liquid and vapor. Vapors may travel to ignition sources and flash back. Containers exposed to heat may rupture.
